Introduction

- God is working today!
- This is great day of redemption you have been waiting for.
- This is the day that whoever cries out to the Lord will be saved.

CROSS!!*

The Miracles of Jesus

- Miracles = the supernatural things that Jesus did.
- Wonders = the effect it had on the people who witnessed them.
- Signs = the reason for the miracles was to declare to all that God was in Him.

“as you yourselves
know!”

Acts 2:22

The Prophecies of Jesus

- *“this Man, delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God, you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death” (Acts 2:23).*
- All the prophecies about Christ show Him to be LORD.

The Resurrection of Jesus

- “you put this man to death” (Acts (2:23))
- “but God raised Him up, putting to end the agony of death and freeing Him from its power.” (Acts 2:24)
- He repeats “God raised Him from the dead and we are all witnesses” (Acts 2:32)

Therefore let all the house of Israel
know for certain that God has made Him
both Lord and Christ--this Jesus whom
you crucified."
